Rio Olympic Games ICF Family Tickets for Canoe Sprint and Canoe Slalom

The ICF is happy to confirm that the Rio 2016 has allocated spectator tickets for sale to individuals, National Federation and to the Canoeing family.

There are A and B ticket Categories attributed to ICF family for Canoe Slalom and Canoe Sprint. Tickets will be sold to individuals in sets and not by individual tickets.

For example for Canoe Sprint a package includes (6) B category tickets, one ticket per day for each of CF001, CF002, CF003, CF004, CF005 and finally CF006. The price is 180 US Dollars or 160 Euros.

The Canoe Slalom package will include (2) A tickets for Heats and (3) B Category for Finals, one ticket per day. The price is 200 US Dollars or 175 Euros.

You can buy tickets for family and friends however, due to Brazilian law, each ticket is sold to an individual person and they cannot be resold once they are bought under a specific name. So, once you complete your order, you have to indicate in front of each ticket (or set) the name (or title for example: Mr. Jones or Mrs. Smith) who is going to use those tickets. Any person found to be selling the tickets will be removed from the Games and ICF will take actions against them. It is a criminal offence to resell tickets in Brazil.

Rio Organising Committee has demanded full payment to the ICF for the 3000 tickets allocated. We ask for your understanding as we try to provide this service and thank you in advance for your quick payment. Once the deadline is passed and the invoice is issued, the ICF will not accept any return or refund.
