ABOUT PUTRAJAYA FEDERAL TERRITORY, MALAYSIA



Putrajaya, city and federal territory of Malaysia, located in west-central Peninsular Malaysia. It is situated 15 miles (30 km) south of the capital, Kuala Lumpur, and serves as the country's administrative centre. Putrajaya is Malaysia's administrative capital, officially declared a Federal Territory in 2001. It was developed to ease congestion in Kuala Lumpur and now houses most of the country's government offices, including the Prime Minister's Office at Perdana Putra. The city is known for its modern yet elegant architecture, vast green spaces, and impressive bridges spanning its artificial lake.

The Putrajaya Lake , a 650-hectare man-made lake, is designed to act as a natural cooling system for the city and also for recreation, fishing, water sports and water transport. The lake and its surrounding areas form Putrajaya's most popular resource for informal recreation as a waterfront city. The lake has an average depth of 6.60 metres and a catchment area of 50.9 square kilometres. The well-known Putra Mosque (Pink Mosque), Tuanku Mizan Zainal Abidin Mosque (Iron Mosque), and Millennium Monument (Malaysia) are located on its shores.

WEATHER



Similar to Malaysia, Putrajaya's climate is typically tropical with hot and humid conditions throughout the year. Over the course of the year, the temperature typically varies from 23°C to 32°C (74°F to 91°F). The best times of year to visit Putrajaya for hot-weather activities are from early June to early October and from mid December to mid March.
