The 2025 season is about to start soon. We would like to give you some updates about the discipline and this year's competitions:

- Entries for all major ICF Canoe Sprint events are open in SDP. Please find the list of events valid for the 2025-2028 seasons <u>here</u>.
 Please note that C4 events being part of the programme will be reviewed after the conclusion of the 2026 season with regards to the participation statistics and the Canoe Sprint Committee reserves the right to remove them from the programme if C4 competitions are not going to be viable.

- 6. 5000m races throughout the season (Szeged, Poznan and Milan) will be run in the same format as in 2023 and 2024: with 6 laps and 5 portages.
- 7. The Junior/U23 World Championships will also keep the same format from the two previous seasons, the 5000m races will be organised as mixed relay events.
- 8. Please review the <u>Canoe Sprint Rulebook</u> as it has been updated in accordance with the changes approved at the 2024 ICF Congress.
