## 5. CATEGORIES

### ICF World Ranking Categories

These categories award official ICF ranking points.

Prize money applies only to ICF World Ranking Open categories.

### Festival Categories

- Technical Race (iSUP)
- Technical Sprint Race (iSUP)
- Team Race (XXL SUP)
- SUP Polo

Festival categories are open to all participants and do not include prize money.

## 6. EQUIPMENTS RULES

- Maximum board length: 14'
- ICF races: Hard boards only
- Festival races: iSUP allowed
- Paddle must be single blade
- Foils and motorized systems are not allowed

## 8. COMPETITION RULES

- Athletes must stand on the board during the race
- Start and finish must be completed standing
- Fair play is mandatory
- Interference with other competitors may result in disqualification
- Official ICF rules apply

## 9. SAFETY & MEDICAL

- Safety boats and rescue teams will be present
- Leash is mandatory
- All participants must be able to swim
- First aid services will be available on-site

## 10. ANTI-DOPING

Doping control may be conducted in accordance with ICF and WADA regulations.

## 11. ACCOMMODATION & LOGISTICS

A wide range of accommodation options are available in Kemer and Antalya, catering to all budgets.
