








## 6. COMPETITION VENUE LAYOUT










#### 7. ACCOMMODATION

#### **Room Types and Rates**

One Bedroom (Single)

#### 8. TRANSPORTATION

#### Airport Transfer Upon Arrival and Departure

Airport transfer fares (Airport – Official hotel – Airport) varied due to the distances as follows:

#### 9. BOAT AND EQUIPMENT RENTAL

The HOC has a small fleet of canoe and kayak boats for rent. These boats are used ones with fair conditions and vary in sizes. Therefore, offer for rent is on first come first serve basis and the HOC cannot guarantee the quality nor quantity satisfaction of the services.
