Objectives



Create ranking for athlete comparison



Qualification requirement for WCH, Olympic Games



Make attendance a priority for athletes, NFs



Ensuring funding possibility



Marketing – social media, news, athlete profiles, etc.

Basic principles

- WR points awarded according to places reached in WR events
- Points allocated to the athlete
- Different level of competition – different amount of points distributed (0,25x – 2x)
- WR to be aligned with the competition structure of canoe sprint

- Competitions included: 5 best results (WR points) earned within a calendar year, 10 within 2 years
 - In case an athlete attends lower amount of competitions, they will be ranked lower, even if the points sum is higher than athletes with more competitions attended

- Two-year-cycle – points awarded as per best results of the last 2 years
- WR events and dropout dates to be confirmed in advance (last day of previous month)
- WR published every month

Points sum example for best athletes

Event	Place	Points	Occurrence / 2 years
World Championship	4th	800	2
World Cup	4th	600	6
Continental Championship	4th	500	2
Ranking Race	2nd	337.5	6
National Championship	1st	125	2

- Only 5 best results (points) to be calculated
- „Defending” results from 2 years before
- Worse results in higher ranked events can be replaced by great results in lower ranked events – motivation to take part in RRs

Tiebreaker rules - TBD

- Highest placed athlete on a higher ranked competition closest to the date of publishing
- More World Ranking competitions attended (even if points earned in a competition doesn't count into WR points)
- Better previous ranking
- Better ranking in another category
- Younger athlete
- Randomly assigned (computer)

- **Full competition portfolio** to be reviewed
- **Multipliers** to be set in advance
- **Events distribution** between competitions
- **Continental competition distribution** – capable hosts?
- **Bonus system:** event attendance/world records?
- **NF ranking** to be used? Qualification / funding?
- **Implementation date** (2024?)
- **Eligibility** – DNF, DNS, DSQ
