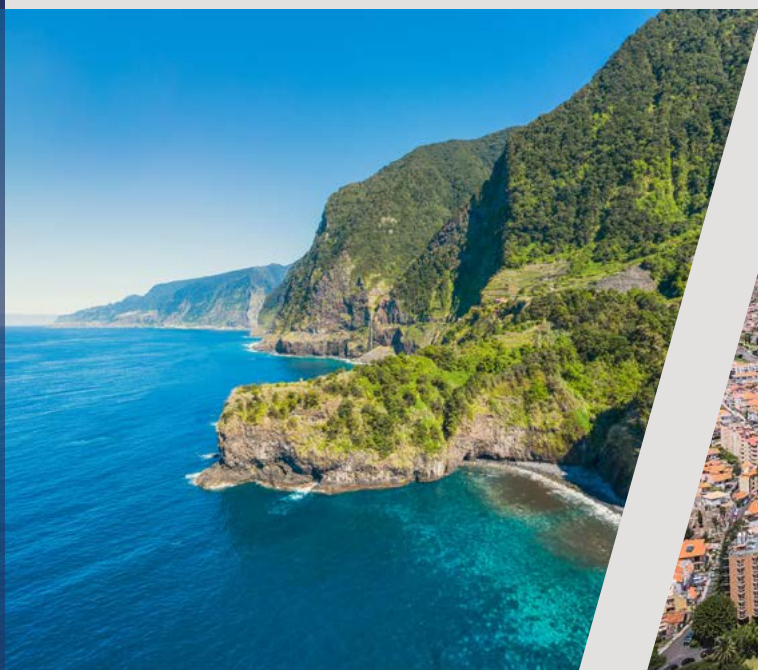

An Outstanding Island Destination

In the heart of the Atlantic, Madeira is repeatedly distinguished as the Best Island Destination in Europe and the World. The contrast between lush subtropical mountains, the deep blue

A Paradise for Sea Canoeing and Surfski

The crystal-clear and deep waters of the region provide ideal conditions for **Surfski and Sea Canoeing**.

From calm areas to more challenging swell, Madeira offers unique experiences for all levels. Paddling along Cabo Girão, exploring sea caves, and spotting dolphins, whales, or turtles makes every ocean outing unforgettable.

Biodiversity and Conservation

The archipelago-comprising Madeira, Porto Santo, Desertas, and Selvagens - has one of the largest marine protected areas in Europe, including full reserves such as the Selvagens Islands, where seabirds like Cory's shearwaters and petrels nest.

The Desertas Islands, in particular, are an essential refuge for the Monk Seal (*Monachus monachus*), one of the world's most endangered species. Their presence highlights the importance of protecting and conserving this unique ecosystem.

Nature on Land: Trails, Levadas and Laurissilva Forest

On land, trails winding through mountains and forests complement the maritime adventure.

The famous **Levadas**, candidates for UNESCO World Cultural Heritage status, lead visitors into the heart of the Laurissilva Forest, a formation around 20 million years old and classified as a **UNESCO Natural World Heritage Site since 1999**.

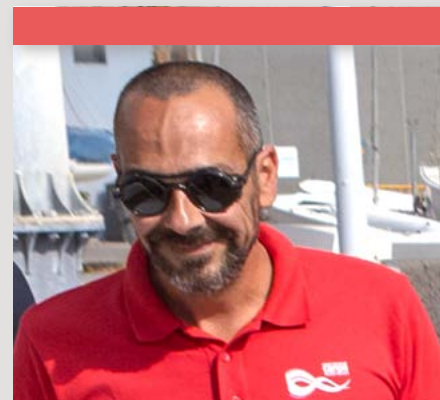
Responsible for technical decision-making, managing sea conditions, and ensuring safety and competitive fairness throughout the entire event.

Age Criteria

- Athletes may compete in international events from the year they turn 15 years old.
- Junior category: valid until the year the athlete turns 18.
- Under 23 category: valid until the year the athlete turns 23.
- Other categories do not require confirmation from National Federations.

No limit on entries per country.

Registration period: February 14 to April 15, 2026

According to MOC organizational guidelines, all participants, including Masters athletes, must present a letter from their federation confirming they have the technical ability to paddle in extreme open ocean conditions.

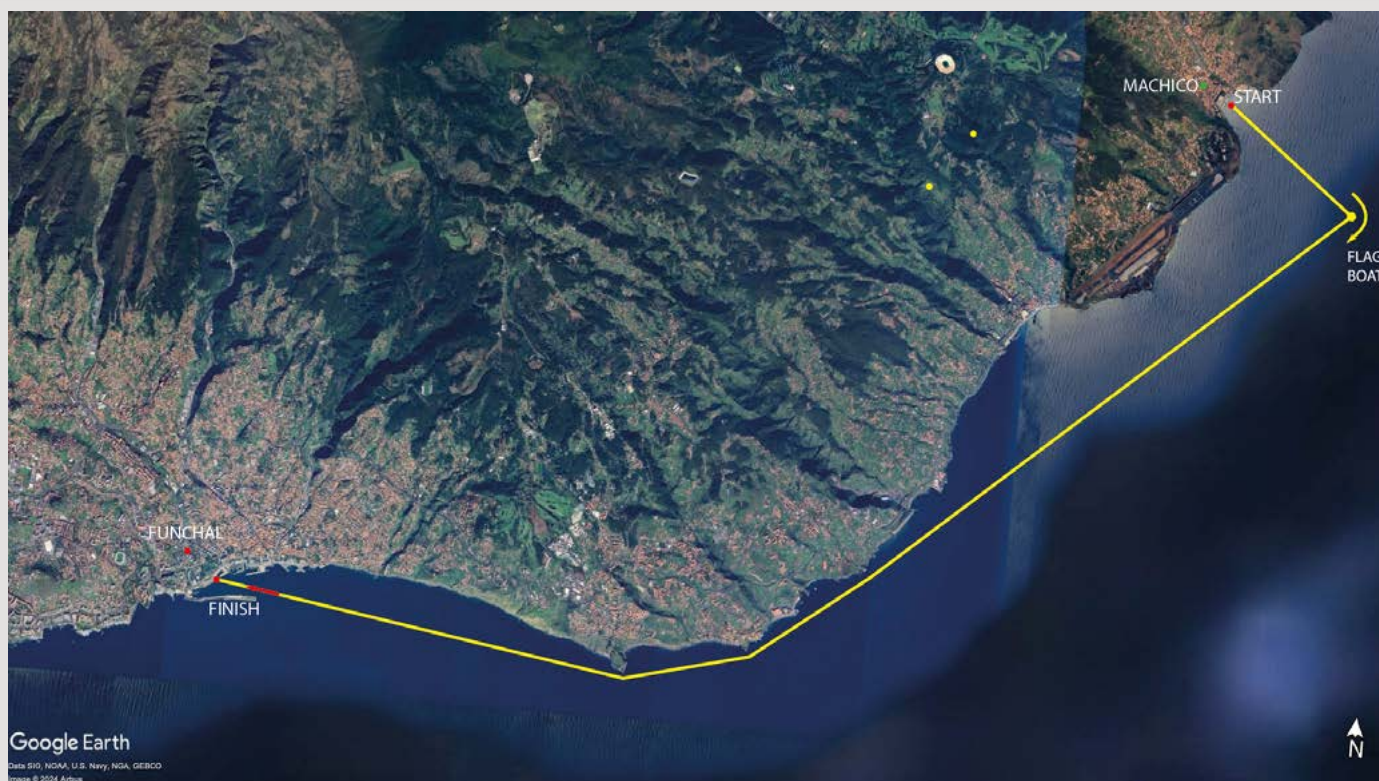

TRANSPORTATION BY VESSELS:

Participants registered for the Madeira Ocean Challenge 2026 will be able to use the boat transport service.

Structures for kayak placement will be mounted in the containers, and the equipment must be properly packed and secured by the respective applicants.

The Madeira Regional Canoeing Association cannot be held responsible for any accident or damage that occurs to the vessels being transported, nor for any failure to meet the dates and times mentioned above for the delivery of the equipment.

We advise all interested parties to properly pack their vessels, using covers, transport plastic or shock-absorbing foam, ensuring that they do not consume volume in the container provided and may impair its maximum expected capacity.



TRANSPORT OF BOATS

Boat transport from the Madeira Ocean Challenge headquarters to the race start area is included in the participation fee. Transport will be carried out on trailers separate from athlete transport.

Maritime transport of boats between mainland Portugal and Madeira is also

included. Boats must be properly packed and delivered in Lisbon or Porto on dates to be announced. Collection will be available from April 29 at the MOC Headquarters.
