from June 20–21, 2026, the club Kanupolo Salzburg warmly invites you to the CANOEPOLO ALPS TROPHY 2026! Join us in beautiful Salzburg city for the battle for the Alpine Trophy.

**NEW:** In 2026, for the first time, we will also have a children's pitch and therefore a dedicated kids division. So it's a competition for both young and old.

**Divisions:** DIVISION I (Adult Mixed) -12 teams max.  
DIVISION II (KIDS U14)

**Pitches:** 2 pitches  
For Div II (Kids): a children's playing field with smaller goals and a smaller field is being made available for the first time.

**Limitation:** For Div I (Adult Mixed): Each club may register a maximum of two teams (goal: to allow as many different teams as possible to participate). A player cannot participate on multiple teams. For Div II (KIDS), there are no restrictions. U14 includes children up to 14 years old (there is no lower age limit; U10 players may also participate).

**Registration Deadline:** **May 31, 2026**

**Entry fee:** 70 € per team

**Time frame:** Saturday 8 AM - 6 PM  
Sunday 8 AM - 4 PM (Final game starts at 3 PM)

**Player catering:** 25 € per person (4 meals)  
(Saturday = breakfast & lunch;  
Sunday = breakfast & lunch)

**Boathouse:** The boathouse of the club Kanupolo Salzburg is located directly on the grounds of the Salzach bathing lake. Overnight stays in the boathouse are not possible.

**Accommodation:** Overnight stays on the grounds of the bathing lake are also unfortunately not permitted by the city. We therefore recommend the campsites "Panorama-Camping-Stadtblick", "Camping Nord-Sam", or one of the nearby guesthouses or hotels.

**Rules:** The tournament will be conducted according to the current ICF Canoe Polo rules. Please note that the material used must comply with the minimum standards applicable in Austria (-> see „Kanupolo Österreich, Material Guide“) <http://www.kanupolo-salzburg.at/services/#materialguide>

**Referees:** Referees and the competition committee will be provided by the participating clubs. The respective referee assignments (including competition committee duties) are indicated in the match schedule.

**Liability:** Participation in the event is at your own risk. Kanupolo Salzburg and its representatives disclaim any liability, including towards third parties. By registering, participants confirm that they are able to swim.
