remove team events (always troubles to make them official) and merge the WWC Sprint Worlds with CSL World Championships

II. development

informative part, reality dealing:

- we have built the policy for the TIP Development Team selection following the ICF criteria: gender equity, targeting mainly u23 athletes, welcoming nations in the program for 2 years maximum
- here we have 8 nations, 11 athletes, 3 coaches, 1 logistic assistant
- this TIP Development camp is run by an ICF Organizing Committee budget
- supported nations are: BRA, CAN, EST, HUN, IRL, ROU, UKR, VEN
- nations that were keen to help with the boat rental: AUT, CZE, CRO, ESP, FRA, GBR, NED, IRL, SLO, SUI, SVK
- we were trying to organize also material help for the overseas countries, which was in the end complicated in a point of the total number of boats, very probably we will leave this kind of help in their hands for the next events
- we cannot support everyone every year, we would like to focus on bringing new countries + developing the canoe categories

- What should we focus on more? The development of coaches or athletes or both at the same time?

SLO idea

2 years of being in the TIP or any of the supporting programs is not enough because they will be taking part on just two events, not enough for the inclusion.


Coaches needs to be connected between countries and not through the ICF program.
