All participants of the event must be accredited, since no access is granted to the venue without an accreditation badge. Please be advised that you will not receive the badges until your balance with the Host Organising Committee is cleared to zero.

AIRPORT TRANSFERS

ARRIVAL: upon entering the Arrival Hall, please search for our staff. Our team members will provide you with additional details regarding your transportation to Szeged.

DEPARTURE: an information sheet on the departure pick-up time and location will be posted on the wall next to the Accreditation Centre one or two days prior to your scheduled departure.

SHUTTLE SERVICE

A shuttle bus service will run daily between the official hotels and the Regatta Course during the access period. The schedule and walking maps will be available at the official website of the event, in the hotel lobbies and at the Szeged Olympic Centre as well. The shuttle service is accessible to all participants with an accreditation badge.

LATE ENTRY / WITHDRAWAL / CREW CHANGE

In extraordinary circumstances, an application can be submitted to the Chief Official for the acceptance of late entries or withdrawals. It is at the Chief Official's discretion to approve or deny late entries or withdrawals. Requests for late entry, withdrawal, or crew changes can be made through the following online form: https://forms.gle/gVlemQAQydBzwkwGA

Late athlete entries will be subject to a fee of 50 EUR per athlete.

Late event entries for already registered athletes will incur a fee of 50 EUR per boat.

Please note that payments will only be accepted via credit card or cash at the Accreditation Centre. Only requests submitted before the deadline will be considered. After the deadline, please contact the Chief Official directly.

DEADLINE TO SUBMIT REQUESTS: 18th September, 11:00.

- 1. Any athlete listed in the final entry for their country is eligible to substitute in any other event.
- 2. Any changes to entries must be communicated through the online form to the Chief Official at least one hour prior to the first race of the morning or afternoon session.
- 3. Withdrawal of an entry is final and prohibits the same athlete or crew from participating in any other events of the competition.
- 4. For crew boats, the competitors' names must be listed in the order they will race in the boat. The name at the top must correspond to the competitor positioned at the front of the boat.

ID CHECK

All athletes must present a valid passport or ID to verify their country of citizenship and birth year. Team Leaders are responsible for collecting the passports of their athletes and submitting them at the designated office located on the groundfloor of the VIP building (accessible from the Athletes' Area). This can be done on Tuesday, 17th September, from 15:00 to 18:00, or on Wednesday, 18th September, from 8:00 to 12:00.

BOAT STORAGE AND PARKING

Boat racks are provided either in the boathouse or at the tents in the Athletes' Area. You are requested to take your trailers to the designated trailer parking area located on the Southern dam. Each team gets ONE parking permit for free, further parking stickers can be added for 50 EUR/car/competition.

For accreditation purposes, we provide temporary parking near the Accreditation Centre.

BOAT NUMBERS AND PERSONAL NUMBERS

The personal numbers to be worn during the whole duration of the competition will be provided to the Team Leaders at the Accreditation Centre. The boat numbers can be collected one hour before the competition at the designated place in the Athletes Area. The Team Leader must leave a deposit (50 EUR) upon collecting the start number for the first time. The deposit will be refunded at the end of the competition when the Team Leader has returned all.

Name and country code stickers are not mandatory for this event.

ID CONTROL

Athletes can embark only from the designated place before the competition where their boats, equipment, clothes (uniforms and uniformity), personal numbers, boat numbers and accreditation cards will be checked.

SECOND (POST-RACE) BOAT CONTROL

Following the race, certain boats will be selected for a second boat control. Athletes are required to disembark onto the designated pontoon, where their boats will undergo this control. Remember to check the weight of your boat at the self-check station before the race.

PRE-RACE PROCEDURE

Only athletes scheduled for the upcoming race start will be allowed to enter the designated starting areas located between 200-300m, 500-600m, and 1000-1100m. They will be called to the starting area 2-3 minutes before the start of the race. Once the boats enter the starting area, they are prohibited from turning around and must paddle directly towards their assigned starting machine.

Aligners will be stationed at the onset of the starting area – at 300m, 600m, or 1100m – to supervise the movement of the boats.

Athletes are advised to adhere to the instructions provided by the aligners and refrain from entering the starting area unless officially called and involved in the next race.

TRAFFIC REGULATION DURING RACE DAYS

There is one-way traffic on the water. Athletes are requested to use the channel behind the dividing island to paddle up to the start. The Regatta Course can be reached through the cuts above the 500m, 1000m starts. From there traffic goes in the direction of the Finish Tower. It is absolutely forbidden to use motor boats during the official training, coaches, however, are permitted to follow the athletes by bikes on the service path along the course.

SAFETY REGULATIONS ON WATER

The HOC offers lifeguard services on the water during official training sessions and on race days starting one hour before the start of the first race. It is important to note that the HOC cannot guarantee full surveillance of the entire water surface of the venue. Therefore, please ensure to paddle only in the areas being guarded.

GUARDED AREAS DURING OFFICIAL TRAINING SESSIONS:

- The race course between 1300m and the finish line
- The water surface in front of the boathouse up to the bridge

GUARDED AREAS DURING RACE DAYS:

- The race course between 1300m and the finish line
- The water surface in front of the boathouse
- The channel behind the dividing island up to 1300m

Please remember: the HOC disclaims responsibility for any incidents occurring in areas without supervision and beyond the official training times.

CYCLING AT THE VENUE

Coaches are allowed to follow the races by bike on the dividing island, which can be accessed by the connecting bridge.



TEAM LEADERS' MEETING & COMMUNICATION

The Team Leaders' meeting will take place in person on Wednesday, 18th September at 16:00 in the meeting room located behind the grandstands. All Team Leaders are invited to join the 2024 Olympic Hopes TL WhatsApp group by scanning the QR code or click on **this link**. The Competition Committee and the HOC will share all essential information to the teams through this group.



MEDAL AWARDING CEREMONIES

All athletes (wearing their national outfit) are requested to be present at the Finish Tower 10 minutes prior to the officially scheduled victory ceremony at the latest. We have a very tight schedule therefore we kindly ask you to be aware of this request. Victory ceremonies will start at their officially scheduled time sharp. In case an athlete arrives late to the meeting point, ceremony will start on time without him/her. The Team Leader of the winning nation is also kindly requested to arrive at the medal awarding ceremony meeting point 10 minutes before the scheduled start to present the flowers during the event.

Please note that caps, sunglasses, and flags are not permitted on the podium.

MEDICAL CARE

A medical centre will operate at the Regatta Course with ambulance, first aid and doctor on duty. Hospital and clinic assistance for the official participants of the Olympic Hopes Regatta are to be covered by their medical insurance policy, the Host Organising Committee is not responsible for any expenses related to hospital treatment, dental treatment, or any other medical treatment.
