I. PRINCIPLES OF THE OLYMPIC QUALIFICATION RANKING

- The ranking period runs from 20 July 2026 to 3 October 2027.
- There are six dedicated Olympic Qualification Ranking lists, one for each Olympic event
- The ranking list is nominal; each athlete is given a ranking based on their points.
- Maximum of five best results (highest points) of each athlete are counted for during the ranking period in each event.
- The full list of Olympic Qualification Ranking Competitions is outlined in section 2.
- The point allocation table per event is outlined in section 3.
- If two or more athletes have equal points on the Olympic Qualification Ranking, the following tie-breaker rules decide in ranking them in the respective order:
 1. The athlete with the higher registered ranking point in the respective event from the 2027 Canoe Slalom World Championships will rank higher.
 2. The athlete with the higher registered ranking point in the respective event from the 2026 Canoe Slalom World Championships will rank higher.
 3. The athlete with the better 5th result on the respective Olympic Qualification Ranking (meaning the lowest of the 5 counted results) will rank higher.

C. Generic to all the events

- DNS - zero points

- DSQ - minus one hundred (-100) points
- DQB - minus three hundred (-300) points

If an athlete is suspended or banned because of any anti-doping related reason or subject to other disciplinary sanctions, all Olympic Qualification Ranking points will be annulled for the athlete concerned. The points for athletes ranked after will be re-attributed.
