1. ACCOMMODATION

1. How will work Hotel Novotel (bed & return hotel) during the Olympic Games period regarding the following topics:

- Shuttle bus (way: Novotel – canoe slalom venue?, way: Novotel – Olympic village?), from what date will be provided and how many times per hour?
- Security check system in Novotel.
- Possibility to go outside from the Hotel?
- Food in hotel: Open all day long as in OV (full board with buffet?)
- Who will have access to Novotel?

Paris 2024's answer: In order to have all the details regarding bed and returns hotels' services, you should refer to your NOC. But please find below some elements we can share:

- Shuttle bus will be provided from the 19th of July to the 5th of August for canoe slalom. On the 19th of July, there will be precise time but from the 20th of July, there will be a bus leaving the hotel every 30min.
- Security check system: there won't be any check to enter the hotel (but please refer to your NOC for more details), but there will be one when you will enter the bus to go to Vaires-sur-Marne Nautical stadium (VNS).
- There is no rules about going out.
- Food & access to the hotel: refer to your NOC

2. P ACCREDITATION

1. How many can each team have?

Paris 2024's answer: Each **NOC** will have one P accreditation per discipline, which means that you should have 1. However, this one can be used by several people but not at the same time. For instance, if we have coach A and coach B:

- Day 1, 08:00 – 10:00: coach A is on the venue using the P accreditation, coach can't access the venue.
- Day 1, 10:00: coach A is leaving the venue and give the P accreditation to coach B. This one can then access the venue.

2. Where does this accreditation give access to and not access?

Paris 2024's answer: The P accreditation will be valid for the full training and competition period of canoe slalom and will give access to the following accredited "White + 2" areas:



- areas dedicated to canoe slalom
- areas shared with canoe sprint and rowing.

With a P accreditation, you can't access the OVR, the media zones, the Olympic Family Lounge however you have access to the island. To access the close bank, you will need an upgrade during competition time that will be provided to your Team leader at the Sport Information desk.

3. P accreditation: is food/transport included?

[Paris 2024's answer](#): No.

4. P accreditations restrictions are only for Canoe slalom, not including sprint or rowing?

[Paris 2024's answer](#): P accreditation are linked to a discipline.

5. When will you give the upgrade passes?

[Paris 2024's answer](#): The blue zone is only activated during the competition days, so the upgrades won't be needed during the official training week. The upgrades will be distributed during the week.

6. If we switch from P to Ro, can we do this at the VNS accreditation office?

[Paris 2024's answer](#): Please go to your NOC but be aware that accreditations **can't** be created and printed on venue (just validation of your pre-valid card available).

3. LOGISTICS & VENUE ACCESS

1. When can we bump out and take equipment from the venue before the final day of competition?

Can we bring this equipment back onto site (in case we want to take a boat off site for training)?

[Paris 2024's answer](#): If you want to bump out before the end of the competition, you can. If you want to go train somewhere else for kayak cross for instance, you can take out of the venue your boat and bring it back on venue but please not on a daily basis. One time should be enough.

2. What about trailers? Can be left at the venue on the 12th until the end of the competition?

[Paris 2024's answer](#): Not possible due to security check operations.

3. No vans or cars, but what about trailers? Can be left at the venue on the 12th until the end of the competition?



Paris 2024's answer: Not possible from the 12th of July due to security check operations. From the 19th of July until the end of the competition, it is possible.

4. *Do we need accreditation for dropping the boats on 19th?*

Paris 2024's answer: If you just bring the trailer on the trailer park, you don't need an accreditation for the driver. However, you will need a dedicated car pass. If you want to enter the venue, an accreditation is needed.

5. *Where can teams give the details concerning the number of trailers, etc?*

Paris 2024's answer: You will receive a survey where you will be able to share all the details.

6. *For those without accreditation, do we need a Games Pass to access the red zone around the venue?*

Paris 2024's answer: The red zone is only a limited area for car. You can access it walking.

7. *When we take non accredited individuals by car (with VAPP) to the venue do we need Games Pass please?*

Paris 2024's answer: As long as this person doesn't want to enter within the venue, you don't need.

4. TVS

1. *In the technical filming at comp venues document it specifies we can film from the bank and athlete spectator area. Can we have clarity on the map where these areas are? And what specific areas close to the course might be out of bound?*

Paris 2024's answer: During official training, demonstration and competition days, the use of fixed or non-operated cameras is prohibited throughout the Olympic site. Manual cameras, tablets and smartphones are permitted on the two riverbanks (bridges not permitted) during those periods, respecting cautiously the position of ITOs, cameras and water safety.

2. *Can we get details about the video downloading system? Will be same system as Tokyo2020?*

Paris 2024's answer: Same system as the World Cups and World Championships.



3. *Will there be wifi at the video room? (not to connect to the downloading computer but to other devices)*

Paris 2024's answer: Yes there is close, but please do not download using it.

5. TEAM AREAS

1. *Are the team rooms upstairs?*

Paris 2024's answer: For canoe slalom, the rooms are downstairs (nearby the classrooms).

2. *Is there still possibilities to have extra team space?*

Paris 2024's answer: No, the deadline was beginning of the year. But check with your NOC, they might have booked a tent for the rowing or canoe sprint athletes.

3. *What items are prepared by organizer in the team room?*

Paris 2024's answer: In each room, there will be one table, two chairs and a fan.

4. *The way to use the 1500 W in the team room is on us?*

Paris 2024's answer: It is as long as you respect the non-prohibited list of items and not overloaded.

6. SUPPORT SERVICES

1. *During the Games, Team China doesn't have translator, does the organizing committee have solution about this issue?*

Paris 2024's answer: Please liaise with your NOC for this kind of service.

2. *Expected bus time between the village to the venue (with access)?*

Paris 2024's answer: Around one hour.

3. *Is it possible to validate the accreditation on the course?*

Paris 2024's answer: Yes, it is possible at the Venue accreditation center (VAHO) with presentation of your Pre Valid Card (PVC) and your linked identity document. Reminder, no printing available.



4. *Is there any consideration on how teams can bring in heavy equipment into the venue (ice bath's, kayak cross boats etc.)*

Paris 2024's answer: No plan to provide support on it up to now.

7. KAYAK CROSS

1. *Is all kayak cross training with the race course set out through the training week?*

ICF's answer: Yes, it will be.

8. VARIOUS TOPICS

1. *We heard something about day pass, can this access to the FOP?*

Paris 2024's answer: Paris 2024 will check internally but it is not related to sport. Do not hesitate to go to your NOC for more information.
