COURSE

The 2,400-metre long, 122-metre-wide regatta course is located two kilometres south of Szeged. Being an artificial course, current is not an issue here and it is quite well sheltered from strong winds as well. It is equipped with a new Albano system and has nine lanes along with a separate warm-up line. There will be electric time keeping with a photo finish camera and video recording. Automatic starting system will be used for the start. The facility fully meets the ICF requirements.

ANTI-DOPING

For the ICF World Cup each athlete, coach and support personnel must pass the relevant anti-doping online course on the Anti-Doping Education Learning platform (ADEL) corresponding to their role. More information on the website:

HOTEL BOOKINGS AND TEAM REGISTRATION IN THE HMS

Kindly note that hotel reservations and team registrations (without a hotel reservation) must be submitted via the HMS (Hospitality Management System) at <https://hms.digicorp.hu/login>

Please, be informed that registering your team in the online system (arrival & departure dates, no. of persons) is a must even if you are planning to book your accommodation independently from the Host Organising Committee.

Prior to logging in for the first time, please, send an email to booking@szeged2026.com even if you have used the system earlier, since we need to add the new event to your profile.

Please, note that email modification requests cannot be accepted and will not be considered: all changes should be indicated exclusively – before and after the deadlines – in the online system.

Please, remember that no booking or modification request can be considered as confirmed until you get a notification on it from the HOC.

TEAM INFORMATION FORM

In preparation for the upcoming 2026 ICF Canoe Sprint World Cup, we are gathering essential information to ensure that all participating teams receive the necessary support and services.

We kindly ask you to complete the following **Google Form** with your team's basic information, including the contact details of the onsite team leader, any food allergies, the number of boats delivered and any other relevant details.

This information is vital for the Host Organising Committee to make the necessary arrangements and ensure a smooth and inclusive event for all participants.

for planning and coordination.**

ACCOMMODATION PACKAGES

Hotel reservations can be made through the HOC in four different categories, based on the room types and prices listed below. Each accommodation package includes three meals per day: breakfast and dinner served at the designated hotel and lunch provided at the Regatta Course. The accommodation package fee is required to be paid daily throughout your team's stay. For reservations before 5 May and from 10 May please refer to the section on training camps or inquire with the HOC for individual pricing.

CATEGORY 1 (3-STAR SUPERIOR AND 4-STAR HOTELS)

- single occupancy¹ 195 EUR/person/day
- double occupancy² (twin/double room) 170 EUR/person/day

CATEGORY 2 (2-STAR SUPERIOR AND 3-STAR HOTELS)

- single occupancy 165 EUR/person/day
- double occupancy (twin/double room) 140 EUR/person/day
- triple occupancy³ 115 EUR/person/day

CATEGORY 3 (2-STAR AND 3-STAR HOTELS AND GUEST HOUSES)

- single occupancy 140 EUR/person/day
- double occupancy 130 EUR/person/day
- triple occupancy 110 EUR/person/day

CATEGORY 4 (2-STAR MOTELS, GUEST HOUSES, HOSTELS)

- single occupancy 115 EUR/person/day
- double occupancy 110 EUR/person/day
- triple occupancy 100 EUR/person/day
- quadruple⁵ occupancy 90 EUR/person/day

² two persons sharing the same room. Please, choose a twin room in case you need two single beds or a double room in case the 2 persons would share a double bed

Please keep in mind that due to the limited availability of hotel rooms in various categories, reservations will be accepted on a 'first-come, first-served' basis. This means your team may be redirected to a different category than initially requested unless there is sufficient space available in the required category.

Check-in is from 15:00 and rooms must be vacated by 10:00 on the morning of departure. Upon request, the hotels will provide storage rooms for an additional fee, which should be paid directly to the property.

Disclaimer: the HOC does not take responsibility for any extra services provided by the hotel, such as minibar, telephone, parking, etc. These costs are to be paid directly at the front desk.

PARTICIPATION FEE

In case your accommodation has been booked independently and not through the Host Organising Committee, you are required to pay a participation fee of 30 EUR / person / day from the day of your arrival. This fee includes basic services but **does NOT include lunch** at the Regatta Course.

Disclaimer: please remember that the HOC cannot be held responsible for the quality and price of individually reserved accommodations, hence we suggest arranging your hotel booking directly with us.

LUNCH

National teams with individual hotel reservations can add lunch at the Regatta Course for 18 EUR / meal / person when purchased online in advance, or 20 EUR / meal / person when purchased on-site. Please note that **orders are accepted until 24 April** and purchases are subject to a 100% cancellation fee after this deadline. Eligibility will be verified by scanning the barcode on the accreditation badge upon entering the catering area, so on-site purchases will not be available. Kindly note that the participation fee and the accommodation packages do not include transportation between the Liszt Ferenc International Airport or Budapest railway stations and the city of Szeged.

AIRPORT TRANSFER

For teams larger than 3 persons arriving together at the same time, we offer transportation between Budapest and Szeged for 38 EUR / person / one-way. Individuals and teams of 3 or fewer requiring transfer should contact the HOC for an individual price.

Please note that if the airport transfer reservation form is not submitted to the HOC by the deadline of 8 April, or if your exact departure date and time are not known by the time of accreditation, the transfer fee will increase to 50 EUR / person / one-way.

PARKING

Teams will receive one parking pass for one trailer and one accredited vehicle (up to 3.5t). The sticker is valid for a maximum vehicle size of a 9-seated minibus for parking behind the Athletes Area. Additional parking stickers are available for 50 EUR / car / competition.

VISA

Participants are encouraged to reach out to the Hungarian Embassy or consulate in their country or the nearest one, well in advance to inquire about visa requirements. The process of obtaining a visa for Hungary can vary depending on the region, so it is advisable to allow for a 45-day processing period to secure the visa in time.

THE TYPICAL STEPS FOR OBTAINING A VISA ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) Booking accommodation via the HOC or sending the confirmation of your hotel booking to the HOC (if booked individually) - please note, the HOC cannot take responsibility for rejection of visa issuance
- 2) Sending the filled-in visa application form to the HOC (booking@szeged2026.com)
- 3) The HOC issues the Letter of Invitation
- 4) Contacting the Hungarian Embassy / Consulate serving in your country / territory and do the paperwork they request from you
- 5) Visa issuance

Please be informed that the HOC will not issue an invitation letter without knowing your team's arrival and departure dates, accommodation details, the number of participants and their identities. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Hungary and the respective embassy or consulate require the same information from us, therefore, we cannot support your request without your cooperation in providing this information.



PAYMENT AND CANCELLATION TERMS

PAYMENTS AND KEY DEADLINES

The accommodation package and participation fees are to be paid as follows:

As outlined above, the hotel reservation deadline is 22 February 2026. Once the HOC confirms your booking, 60% of the total amount will be invoiced with an 8-day payment term, while the remaining 40% is due by 24 April.

Please note that the booking will remain provisional until the payment of the invoice has been received in our bank account.

The Host Organising Committee reserves the right to alter or cancel the reservation until that time. Upon receipt of payment, the reservation will be confirmed. An updated proforma invoice will be sent verifying the arrival of your payment in our bank account.

The participation fee (for those who booked their accommodation independently and not through the HOC) will be invoiced based on the information you submit about your team's stay in the HMS Accreditation Only module. Please ensure that you provide the appropriate data on time so we can arrange lunch, designate a boat storage area, and display a flag for your team.

Please remember that the participation fee does not include lunch, so be sure to add lunch separately upon request. The lunch order will be invoiced with an 8-day payment deadline, which comes with a 100% payment obligation in case it's cancelled after 24 April.

Please ensure you meet the deadline for submitting the nominal entry in the ICF's SDP system.

All accommodation and / or participation fees must be paid in full by 24 April.

CANCELLATION TERMS

Should you cancel or modify your hotel booking, a charge will be made equivalent to any loss suffered by the Host Organising Committee, as itemised below. The amount of the cancellation fee will be calculated as a percent of the accommodation package fee according to the following period of notice given:

No cancellation fee, if cancelled until 22 February 2026

50% cancellation fee, if cancelled between 23 February - 13 March 2026

100% cancellation fee / non-refundable, if cancelled after 14 March 2026

Please, note that in case you submit your room reservation after the reservation deadline (22 February 2026) and we can confirm your request, the relevant cancellation terms will come into effect immediately from the moment of your reservation.

BOAT TRANSPORTATION

Please contact Your Chamber of Commerce or Customs Office to obtain the accurate information regarding the documents necessary for boat transportation.

INSURANCE

All official participants of the World Cup are strongly advised to take out a medical insurance policy in their respective countries.

MEDICAL CARE

All official participants of the World Cup have access to the following medical services: an on-duty doctor, hospital and clinic support. A medical center with ambulance and first aid will be available at the Regatta Course. Any costs beyond basic first aid, ambulance and physiotherapy services must be covered by the athletes' own medical insurance. The Host Organising Committee will not cover expenses related to hospital, dental or any other medical treatments.



TRAINING CAMPS IN HUNGARY

With its nice calm waters and well-known heritage in the paddling sports, Hungary is a popular destination for training camps in 2026. Due to the typically high demand, it is advisable to organize your training camps and reach out to the Hungarian Canoe Federation at booking@szeged2026.com well ahead of time. This will allow us to create a personalized package for you, including transportation and motorboat services.

Hungary is a landlocked country in Central Europe surrounded by Slovakia, Ukraine, Romania, Serbia, Croatia, Slovenia and Austria. The Danube River forms part of Hungary's north-western border with Slovakia, and then flows south through Budapest, dividing Hungary into two general regions. A low, rolling plain known as the Great Hungarian Plain, covers most of the region east of the Danube extending east to Romania and south to Serbia. Hungary has a continental climate with cold, cloudy, humid winters and warm to hot summers.

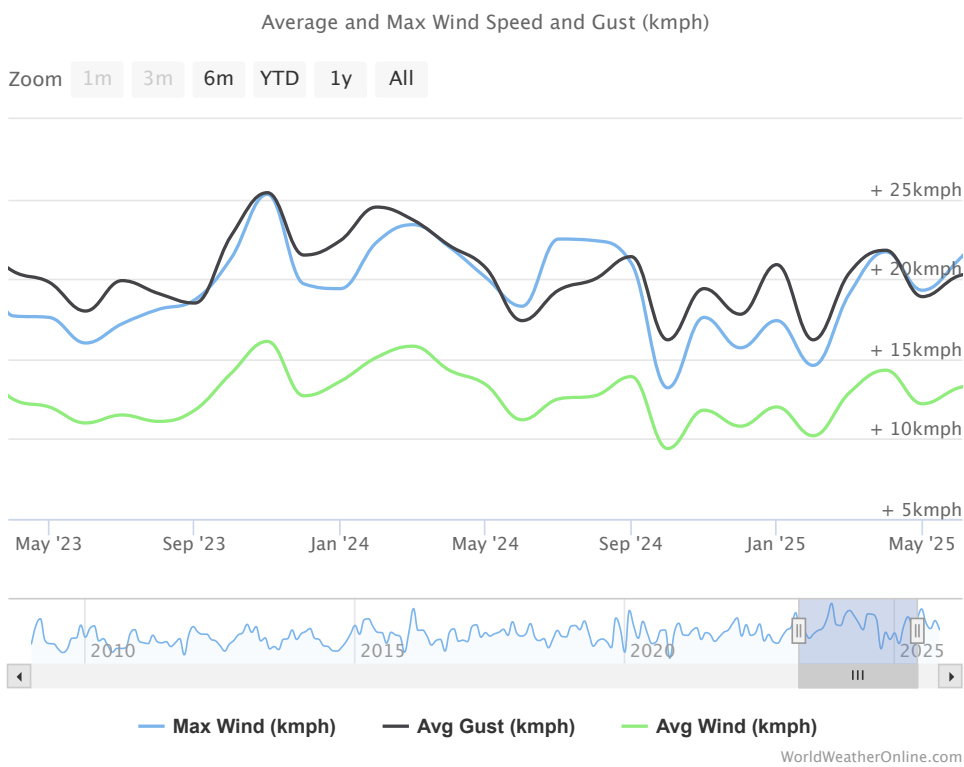
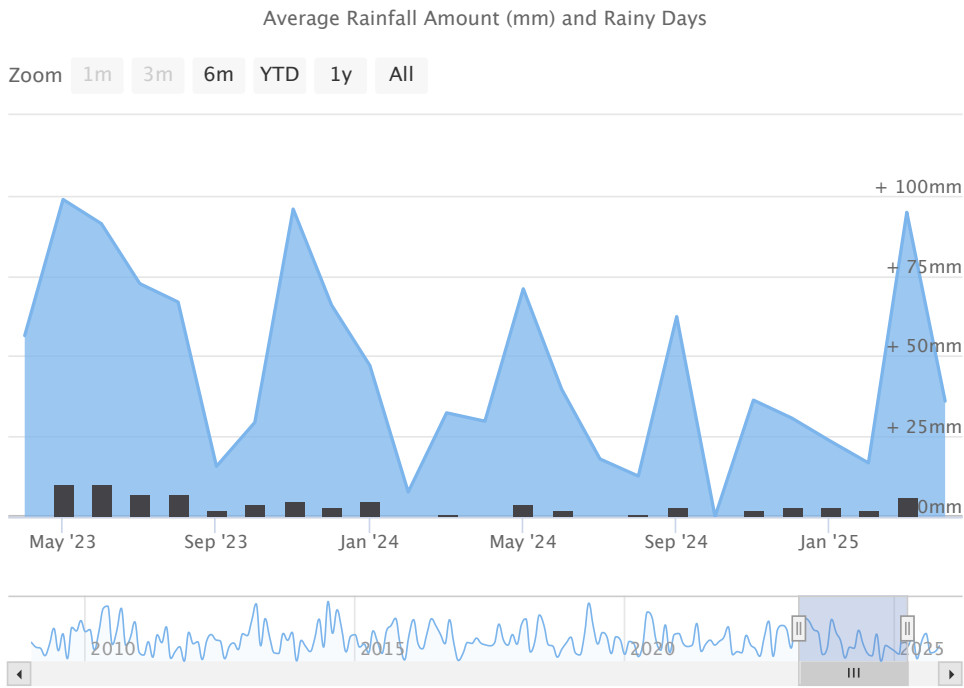
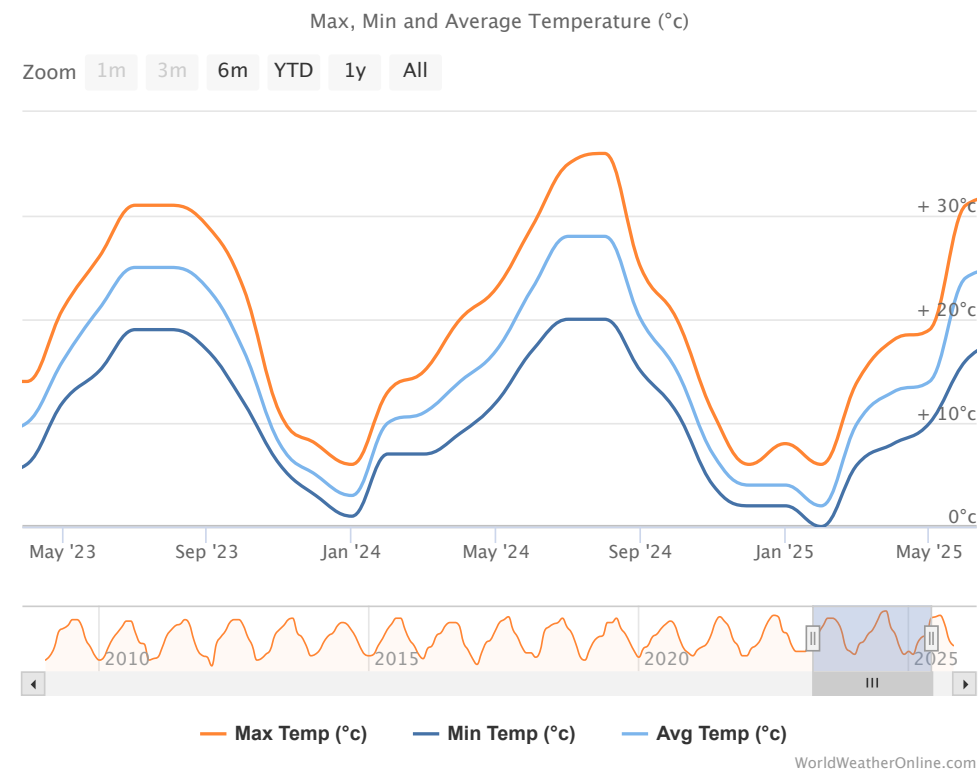
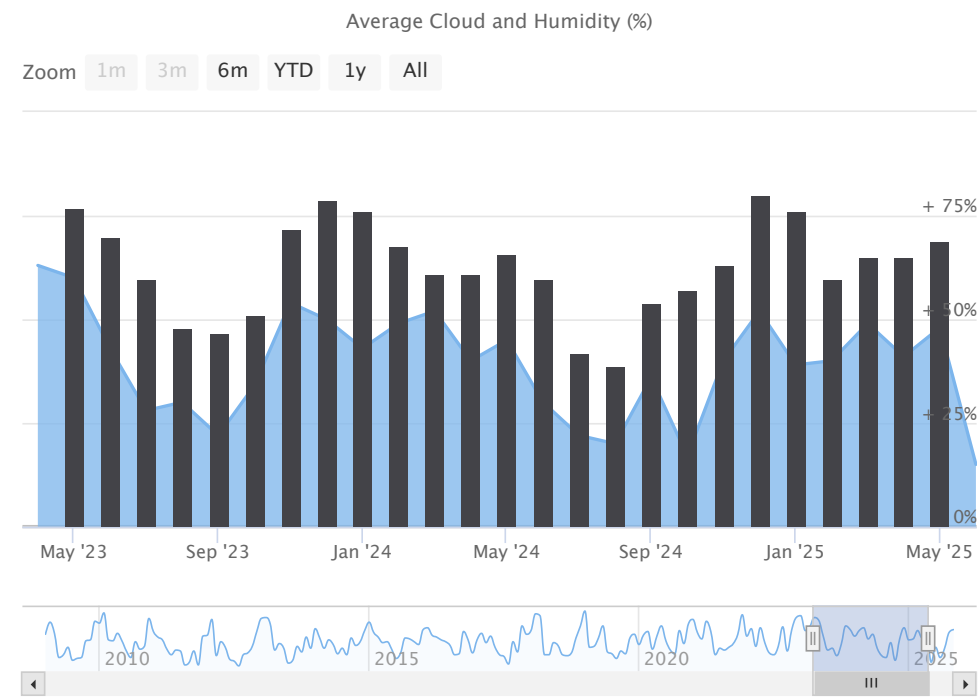
CITY OF SZEGED

Entitled as the capital of sprint canoeing, Szeged is the seat of Csongrád County and the fourth largest city in Hungary. It is situated near the south-eastern border of Hungary right by the Tisza River. A large part of the town lies on the right bank, while Újszeged (New Szeged), a suburban district of residential homes and parks is on the left bank of the Tisza. Szeged is the cultural and economic centre of South-Eastern Hungary and a thriving university town, which is also famous for its open-air theatre.

The city centre is marked by the medieval Tower of St. Demetrius and the stately twin spires of the Votive Church. This cathedral was built in the first decades of the 20th century to commemorate the revival of the city after the devastating flood of the river in 1879. By Hungarian standards, Szeged is a large city, with a population of 177 000. The climate is very favourable of canoeing; the annual mean temperature being about 11 °C (52F), somewhat higher than in the rest of the country. Szeged is sometimes called the City of Sunshine as there is an average of 2 000 hours of sunshine annually.
